HEROES ACT/HEALS ACT

HEROES ACT – HOUSE VERSION

- \$3 Trillion Bill
- \$187.5 Billion directly to County governments
- Adds lost revenue as eligible in CRF
- Maintains December 30, 2020 deadline for CRF
- Removes the 25% match requirement for FEMA

HEALS ACT – SENATE VERSION

- \$1 Trillion Bill
- No new local government funding
- Adds limited lost revenue for CRF (as long as gov't distributed 25% of CRF allocation)
- Extends CRF expenditure deadline (would be March 27, 2022 for EPC)
- FEMA match unchanged, but allocated additional FEMA funding

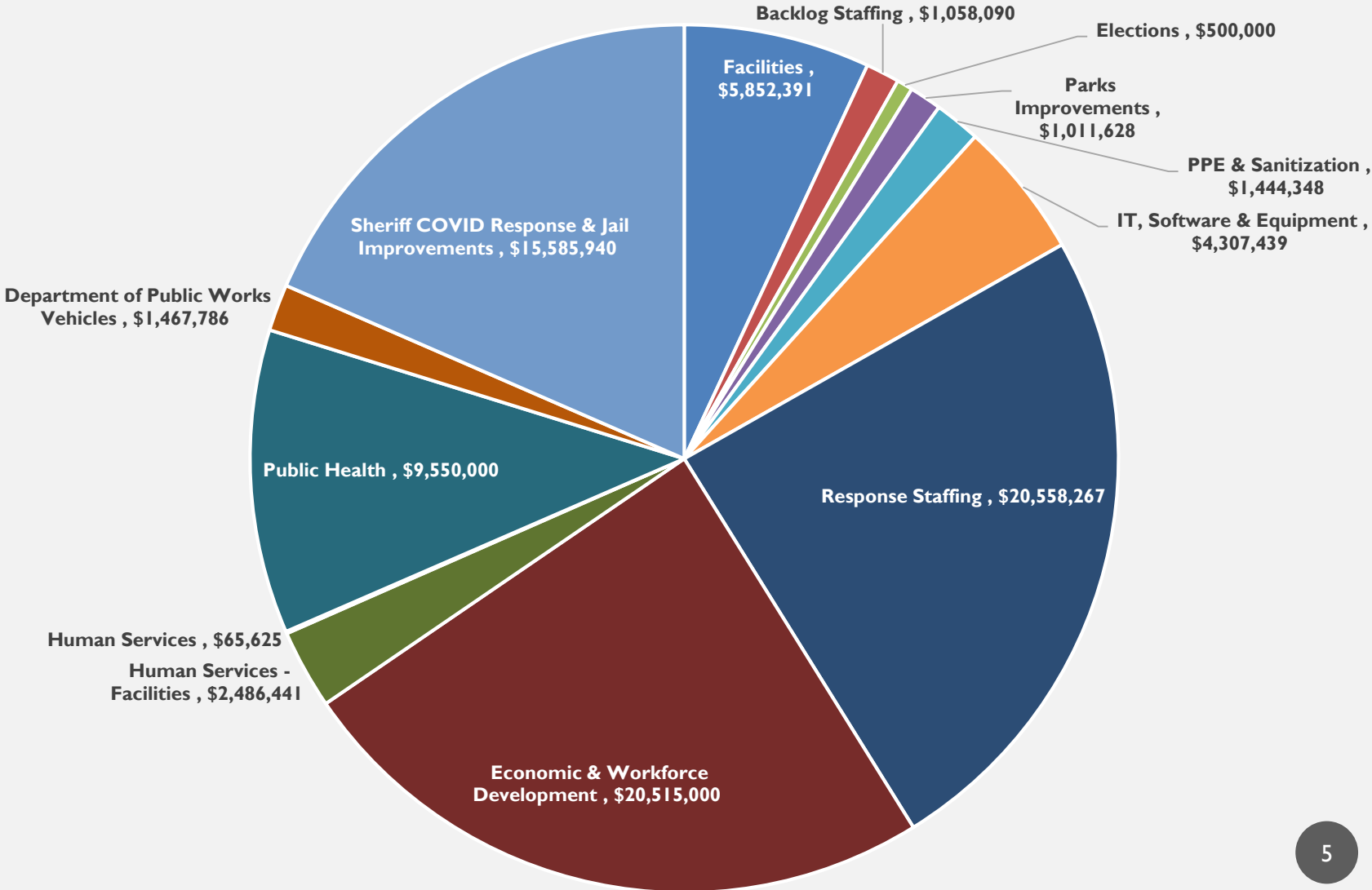
